THE ASSAM OPIUM PROHIBITION (AMENDMENT) ACT,
1961

further to amend the Assam Opium Prohibition Act, 1947.

Preamble. WHEREAS it is expedient to amend further the Assam Opium Prohibition Act, 1947, herein-^{Assam Act XXIII of 1947.} after called the Principal Act, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted in the Twelfth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Assam Opium Prohibition (Amendment) Act, 1961.
