THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (NO. II) ACT, 2014

AN

ACT

to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam for the services of the financial year, 2014-2015.

Be it enacted by the Assam Legislative Assembly in the Sixty-fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

Short title

1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation (No.II) Act, 2014.

Withdrawal of Rs.58425,47,17,000 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam for the financial year, 2014-2015 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam, there may be withdrawn sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the schedule amounting in the agaregate [inclusive of sums specified in column (3) of Schedule to the Assam Appropriation (Vote on Account) Ac., 2014 (Assam Act No.II of 2014)] to the sum of Fifty eight thousand Four hundred Twenty five crore, Fortyseven lakh and Seventeen thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of in ment during the financial year, 2014-2015 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

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Appropriation

3. The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year ending on the Thirty-first Day of March, 2015.
