THE GAUHATI MUNICIPAL CORPORATION  
(AMENDMENT) ACT, 1978

*further to amend the Gauhati Municipal Corporation Act,  
1969.*

Preamble. Whereas it is expedient to amend <sup>Assam Act  
I of 1973.</sup> the Gauhati Municipal Corporation Act, 1969 hereinafter called the principal Act, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted in the Twenty-ninth Year of the Republic of India, as follows:—

Short title,  
extent and  
commence-  
ment.

1. (1) This Act may be called the Gauhati Municipal Corporation (Amendment) Act, 1978.

(2) It shall have like extent as the principal Act.

(3) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 23rd day of August, 1978.

Amendment  
of Section 425  
of Assam  
Act I of 1973.

2. In the second proviso to subsection (1) of Section 425 of the principal Act, the word "three" appearing between the words "of" and "years" in the last line shall be substituted by the word "four".

Repeal and  
Saving.

3. (1) The Gauhati Municipal Corporation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1978 (Assam Ordinance No. I of 1978) is hereby repealed.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal any order passed, notification issued, anything done or any action taken under the principal Act as amended by the said Ordinance shall be deemed to have been passed, issued, done or taken under the principal Act as amended by this Act.
